Minutes
September 1, 2015

The regular meeting of the township supervisors were held on September 1, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at the municipal hall. Present were John Rickard, Peter Suhosky, Dave Sporer, Scott Bennett, and Steve Ostrander. Dave made a motion to approve the minutes and John 2nd it. Steve addressed the board about the Benison property. Scott reported he spoke to Amy Deakin. She sent an email that she paid crews to remove debris from the site. Steve confirmed that the debris was removed and chicken wire was installed over the windows and doors. Scott stated Steve sent him information on the RV problems. Steve reported in his research he found that the lots were too small where the RV's are. One is on two lots. Also there are no permits for the trailers. He also reported that they do not meet set backs and reported other violations. Standard practice has been to send a notice of violation. Scott will review violations and will discuss with the Steve the notice. Scott also proposed on September 30, 2015 the public hearing for Horwath cell towers. The board felt the date would work and if no one objects by 12:00 A.M. on September 2, 2015, Scott will set it up. John brought up Brandon from the Meagher law office to replace Scott Bennett. He would like to have him at the October meeting to observe Scott. Scott agreed and mentioned Jeff Treat as having an interest. Dave reported the grant application for the truck is submitted. We should be notified by mid January, 2016. John reported Reinfurt is ready to allow the township to use a truck for winter maintenance. Dave dropped off the bill for rust repairs on the township's small truck. Pete represented an application to join WIDCO for \$100.00 to be a member. Pete made a motion to join and John 2nd it. Scott reported Wayne County Emergency Management wants the township to adopt an ordinance on hazard mitigation. Dave is going to look into it and report at the next meeting. John made a motion to pay the bills and Pete 2nd it. Pete made a motion to adjourn and Dave 2nd it. All motions were carried unanimously.
