The regular meeting of the township supervisors was held June 4th at seven o'clock at the township hall. Present were Mark Lienert, Peter Suhusky, Scott Bennett, Scott Hanson, Gary Flood, Leonard Schwartz, Margie Schwartz, Shiela Waring and George Eroh. Peter made a motion to approve the minutes, mark 2nd. Leonard approached the board being the owner of Hotel Wayne in Honesdale . They purchased curves and the Hotel Cafe on rte 191 in Cherry Ridge. They are asking for the townships approval of a application to aquire a liquor license. He presented copies of the economic Development Liquor License. Mark made a motion to allow Scott to prepare the necessary announcements and schedule a public hearing for the townships next monthly meeting (July2nd)at 7:00 pm. Peter 2nd. Gary Flood addressed the board about the Garing subdivision. Peter made a motion to approve subdivision, Mark 2nd. George eroh addressed the board from Jehovah Witnesses for there lot improvement. Mark made a motion to approve lot improvement, Peter 2nd. Scott Hanson addressed the board about a neighbor on Lake Shore Drive by Cadjaw. He is now logging and wonders if he is in violation parking his equipment there. After reviewing the zoning map it would appear he is in violation but there would have to be some evidence. The Township will send someone to take a look. Scott reported on FEMA they take the stand that the township does not comply with the flood plan ordinance. He has prepared ordinance 2013-01. Mark made a motion to enact ordinance 2013-1, Peter 2nd. Scott also reported the township has not yet filed against Tom Robinson but he should be served this week. Mark made a motion to give Peter the authority to act for the township if this goes before the magesterial justice. Peter 2nd. Shiela Waring thanked the supervisors for the road repairs. Mark made a motion to approve the bills, Peter 2nd. Peter made a motion to adjourn, Mark 2nd. All motions were carried unanimously
